1: FACE AND BODY PAINTING

THEME: "ALICE IN WONDERLAND"
REGISTRATION TIME: 9.00-10.00am
START AND FINISH TIME: 10.30-2.00pm (3^{1/2} HOURS)
ENTRANTS: MAKEUP STUDENTS

CATEGORY INFORMATION

Tim Burton's amazing version of Alice in Wonderland is a feast for your eyes it's full of quirky Characters, design elements and colour, use these to inspire your imagination and create a design for the face body incorporating the essence of the movie.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The design is your interpretation of "Alice in Wonderland"

Models must be 18 or over

You must register at the registration desk situated at the entrance to the competition area, on the day of the competition at between 9.00 - 10.00am

Competition commences at 10.30 am and finishes at 2pm students have 3^{1/2} hours to complete the face and body paint.

No face and body paint to be applied before the start of the competition

This category incorporates a total look, you must paint the face and **at least half of the body. MODELS MUST NOT BE TOPLESS .**

Your model may wear a body stocking, underwear or similar but this must be painted over.

Partial costume relevant to theme may be worn but **must not cover more than half of the body**

All types of body paint made specifically for the skin are acceptable.

You may use bald caps.

You may paint the head or hair or style the hair or use hairpieces, wigs, extensions, head dresses, hats. or other adornments

No electrical hair equipment or airbrushes are allowed however you may use battery operated hair equipment

No jewellery to be worn unless to compliment the theme

During the final judging models will display students work before a panel of judges

Throughout the competition you must not refer to illustrations, photo`s, pictures, books, mobile phone, etc.

Makeup should not be removed until the competition and prize giving has ended Students will be disqualified for failure to abide by any of the above rules

2: THEATRICAL AND MEDIA MAKEUP

THEME: MICHAEL JACKSONS "THRILLER"
REGISTRATION TIME: 10.00 -10.30AM
START AND FINISH TIME: 11.00AM – 2.00PM (3 HOURS)
ENTRANTS: MAKEUP, STUDENTS

CATEGORY INFORMATION

Michael Jacksons epic video "Thriller" is your inspiration to recreate Michael Jackson himself or one of his entourage of rotting retched fellow zombies. Your character must wear clothing to compliment the theme of your design. All theatrical and media makeup products may be used

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The design is your interpretation of " Thriller"

Models must be 16 or over

You must register at the registration desk situated at the entrance to the competition area, on the day of the competition at between 10.00-10.30am

Competition commences at 11.00am and finishes at 2.00pm,students have 3 hours to complete the makeup.

No makeup to be applied before the start of the competition

Theatrical and media makeup must be applied to head, neck and may also be applied to the body

You may use bald caps, any type of prosthetic's, derma wax, soft putty, film blood, latex and/or any other products made specifically for application to the skin.

Costume may be worn but must be relevant to theme

You may style the hair or use hairpieces, wigs, head dresses, hats or other adornments

No electrical hair equipment or airbrushes are allowed however you may use battery operated hair equipment

No jewellery to be worn unless to compliment the theme

During the final judging models will display students work before a panel of judges

Throughout the competition you must not refer to illustrations, photo`s, pictures, books, mobile phone, etc.

Makeup should not be removed until the competition and prize giving has ended

Students will be disqualified for failure to abide by any of the above rules

ENTRANTS: MAKEUP,HAIR,BEAUTY STUDENTS

CATEGORY INFORMATION

The glamorous 1950's Pin Ups classic beauties such as Marilyn Monroe, Elizabeth Taylor and Ginger Rogers are just a few of the icons of this era, you are required to recreate a total look suitable for this category incorporating makeup, hair, costume and accessories to compliment the theme.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The design is your interpretation of "1950's PINUPS"

Models must be over 16

You must register at the registration desk situated at the entrance to the competition area, on the day of the competition at between 10.30-11.00am

Competition commences at 11.30 am and finishes at 2pm students have 2½ hours to complete the makeup

No makeup to be applied prior to the competition

All types of makeup may be used

False lashes may be used but must be applied during competition time

Hair may be pre -set but must not be styled / dressed until competition starts You may style the hair or use hairpieces, wigs, head dresses, hats or other adornments

CATEGORY INFORMATION

Lady Ga Ga is certainly an avante garde icon of the 21st century her undeniable uniqueness is your Inspiration, let your imagination run wild and create a zany look for Ga Ga. The makeup is priority but the hair, clothing and accessories will help you to create a dead ringer

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The design is your interpretation of "LADY GA GA "

Models must be over 16

You must register at the registration desk situated at the entrance to the competition area on the day of the competition at between 10.30am and 11.00am

Competition commences at 11.30am and finishes at 2.00pm,students have 2½ hours to complete the makeup

No makeup to be applied prior to the competition

All types of makeup may be used

False lashes may be used but must be applied during competition time

Hair may be pre -set but must not be styled / dressed until competition starts You may style the hair or use hairpieces, extensions, wigs, head dresses, hats or other adornments

Hats and headdresses may be used

Nails may be painted during competition time

ENTRANTS: BEAUTY, MAKEUP,HAIR STUDENTS

CATEGORY INFORMATION

You are required to create a natural bridal makeup, for a White Wedding the makeup should be clean, crisp and pristine fit for the blushing bride on her big day. You must complete a total look incorporating hair, dress, nails and accessories etc.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The design is your interpretation of "White Wedding"

Models must be over 16

You must register at the registration desk situated at the entrance to the competition area, on the day of the competition at between 10.30-11.00am

Competition commences at 11.30 am and finishes at 2pm, students have 2½ hours to complete the makeup

No makeup to be applied prior to the competition

All types of makeup may be used

False lashes may be used but must be applied during competition time

Hair may be pre -set but must not be styled / dressed until competition starts

Wigs, hair pieces and extensions may be used

Hats and headdresses may be used

Nails may be painted during competition time

No electrical hair equipment is allowed but you may use battery operated equipment

No airbrushing allowed

Outfit and accessories to be worn to compliment the makeup

Final judging models will display the students work in front of a panel of judges

RULES OF THE COMPETITION

- REGISTRATION: PLEASE REGISTER AT THE CORRECT TIME FOR YOUR CATEGORY
- YOU MUST SUPPLY YOUR OWN MODEL
- YOU MUST HAVE ALL PRODUCTS AND EQUIPMENT YOU REQUIRE FOR THE COMPETITION
- YOU MUST DISPLAY YOUR COMPETITION BADGE AND CARD SO THAT THE JUDGES CAN SEE THEM CLEARLY.
- HANG COATS UP, PUT BAGS UNDER WORKING SURFACES.
- NO ONE IS ALLOWED TO LEAVE THE COMPETITION AREA UNLESS THEY NEED TO USE THE BATHROOM.
- NO MOVING AROUND THE ROOM.
- DO NOT DISTURB ANYONE ELSE
- NO SHOUTING.
- YOU MAY HAVE A BOTTLE OF WATER.
- NO OTHER DRINKS ALLOWED.
- NO FOOD ALLOWED.
- NO SMOKING IN THE COMPLEX
- ALL MOBILE PHONES MUST BE SWITCHED OFF.
- DO NOT LEAVE THE COMPETITION AREA UNTIL THE COMPETITION HAS FINISHED.
- INBETWEEN THE FINAL CATWALK AND PRIZE GIVING DO NOT LEAVE THE BUILDING.
- DO NOT YOURSELF OR ALLOW YOUR MODEL TO TOUCH OR COME INTO CONTACT WITH ANY SURFACES AS THIS MAY RESULT IN IMPOSSIBLE OR HARD TO REMOVE STAINS AND MARKS. BY SURFACES WE MEAN ANY FIXTURES AND FITTINGS IN OR OUT OF THE COMPETITION AREA EG: CARPETS, TABLES, CHAIRS, WATER MACHINES, DOORS, STEWARDS WILL BE AVAILABLE TO ASSIST MODELS.
- ALL TABLES, CHAIRS AND CARPETS WILL BE COVERED IN PLASTIC PLEASE DO NOT REMOVE THIS COVERING
- YOU MUST ALSO COVER WORKING AREAS WITH BEDROLL AND YOUR MODEL MUST STAND OR SIT ON A TOWEL.
- DO NOT LEAVE ANY LITTER, PRODUCTS OR MARKS IN THE BATHROOMS
- PLEASE PLACE ANY LITTER IN THE BIN BAGS PROVIDED.
- ANY DAMAGE TO PROPERTY, FIXTURES AND FITTINGS WILL BE CHARGED TO THE INDIVIDUAL / SCHOOL/COLLEGE /TRAINING PROVIDER OR OTHER RESPONSIBLE
